Blue House



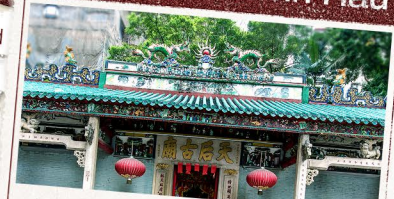
