HK Tramways welcomes the Government's approval on tram fare adjustment

(Hong Kong: 29 May 2018) Hong Kong Tramways ("Tramways") welcomes the Government's decision on its fare adjustment application. This adjustment is crucial for the operational viability of tram services and for sustaining Tramways' service improvement and renewal programs. With the new adjustment, trams still remain as the most affordable transportation in Hong Kong, far behind other modes.

The new fare structure is as below:

	New fares to take effect in 2 July 2018	Amount of increase
Adult	\$2.60	\$0.3
Children	\$1.30	\$0.1
Senior citizen	\$1.20	\$0.1
Monthly ticket	\$220.00	\$20

At the same time, Tramways will keep up the commitment of resources to implement various service improvement projects, including all mandatory renewals to sustain quality service of the tram fleet. Tramways will also keep up efforts in preserving our city's heritage and world-wide recognized icon.

Hong Kong Tramways (Tramways) has been serving Hong Kong since 1904 and operates nowadays a fleet of 164 tramcars including 2 antique party tramcars and 1 unique "TramOramic Tour" sightseeing tramcar. It is the world's largest fleet of double-deck tramcars in operation, carrying up to 200,000 passengers per day. Tramways keeps up efforts in developing a world-wide recognized icon while striving to go beyond the expectations of the 21st century passengers to offer the greenest, most affordable and most space efficient transport mode in Hong Kong.
